

## **OPT Application Check List**

**STEP 1:** Attend an OPT workshop and read ALL information on I-Center website.

**STEP 2:** Confirm completion and/or graduation date with your Academic Dean/Advisor or Registrar.

**STEP 3:** Prepare and gather application materials for application

- 1. Complete Form I-765.
  - a. Refer to this <u>Tip Sheet</u> for completing the I-765.
- 2. Copy of I-94 information, found here.
- 3. Employment Offer Information (Optional)
  - a. You may report your employment information if you have a job offer at the time of application
  - b. A job offer is not required to apply for OPT

## **STEP 4:** Complete Online OPT Application

- Pick up your OPT Recommendation I-20 upon receiving approval email from International Center
- Fletcher Students make appointment with your advisor, Reiko Ohmura, to finalize submission of application and collect new OPT I-20.

## STEP 5: Prepare your OPT Packet for Mailing

- 1. Copy of OPT recommendation Form I-20 (signed by you)
- 2. Completed and signed Form I-765 (signed in blue)
- 3. Copies of <u>ALL Form I-20s</u> that have ever been issued to you, by Tufts and/or previous institutions (do not send originals)
  - a. If you believe you are missing I-20s, please send copies of what you have.
- 4. Copy of most recent I-94 record
- 5. Copy of your most recent F-1 student visa
- 6. Copy of your passport identification page
- 7. \$410 filing fee
- 8. Two recent passport size photos
- 9. Form G-1145

**STEP 6:** Use mailing instructions indicated by the International Center mail your packet to USCIS as soon as possible.

• Your application must be received by USCIS within 30 days of the date the Form I-20 was issued and signed by your advisor.
